CLUB ACTIVITIES

If you enjoy Science Fiction and/or Fantasy, then the following activities of the Club will interest you:

MONTHLY MEETINGS These usually take the form of talk, discussion or film show. Meetings are held in the Gauteng area, usually Johannesburg. The entrance fee is R10.00 per person.

LIBRARY Members may borrow 5 books at a time from the Club library. Over 1 800 titles are presently in stock, and a selection will be on display at most meetings. Our librarian can be approached if you wish to borrow books at times other than meetings. A mailing service is available to country members who cannot attend meetings. Contact the librarian for more details.

CLUB MAGAZINE PROBE is published quarterly and sent to all members. You are invited (encouraged) to contribute letters, articles, short stories and artwork.

MAIN AND MINI CONVENTIONS Once a year, held over two days, is our annual convention, with speakers, movies not often seen, and general socialising. The minicon is a midyear convention for the more serious fan, and consists of a day of talks, discussions, debates, quizzes and wormholes. We also arrange some speciality small conventions.

NOVA SHORT STORY COMPETITION An annual event with monetary prizes for the best science fiction or fantasy stories, in both a South African and a general category. Winning entries are published in PROBE. We accept entries from July, and the competition closes at the end of September.

CORRESPONDENCE We can put you in contact with other SF clubs and fans overseas. We also have some overseas fanzines available.

SUBSCRIPTIONS FOR 2010

Subscriptions are R200 per annum for local members. (In the Gauteng area.)

Subscriptions are R120 per annum for country members. (Not in the Gauteng area.)

Subscriptions are USD 30 / UKP 15 (or equivalent) per annum for overseas or international members. (Not in South Africa.) We ask an additional USD 30 / UKP 15 (or equivalent) if you wish to receive Probe via airmail, and an additional R90 (or equivalent) if you are paying by cheque. The cheque fee is to cover bank charges.

New members in South Africa are also charged a once off R25 joining fee, used for capital projects.
